21 I, MARINA N. VITEK, being duly sworn, states as follows under penalty of perjury:

22
23 1. I am an attorney admitted to practice before all Courts of the State of California,
24 as well as the United States District Court for the Central District of California. This Declaration
25 is submitted in support of the plaintiff's request for award of attorneys' fees and reimbursement
26 of expenses. If called as a witness I would and could testify to the following.

1 2. I am an associate with the law firm of Wasserman, Comden, Casselman & Pearson
2 L.L.P., co-counsel for lead plaintiff, California State Teachers' Retirement System
3 ("CalSTRS"), with the firm of Cotchett, Pitre, Simon & McCarthy. I have been actively
4 involved in the prosecution of this action since its inception.
5

6 3. On December 27, 2001, Wasserman, Comden, Casselman & Pearson filed a class
7 action complaint entitled *T. Jeffrey Simpson v. Homestore.com, Inc., et al.*, United States
8 District Court, for the Central District of California, Western Division, Case No. 01-11115 GAF
9 (CWx). This action was consolidated with eighteen subsequently filed class actions and
10 CalSTRS was appointed as lead plaintiff.

12 4. Wasserman, Comden, Casselman & Pearson L.L.P. is experienced class counsel.
13 A true and correct copy of the most recent listing in the *Martindale-Hubbell* is attached hereto
14 as Exhibit "A." Wasserman, Comden, Casselman & Pearson L.L.P. are experienced in handling
15 fraud actions, shareholder and other complex litigation on behalf of plaintiffs. Examples of
16 such cases are listed in Exhibit "B," many of which I have personally been involved.

18 5. From the outset of this case, Wasserman, Comden, Casselman & Pearson have
19 worked extensively on behalf of the class and with lead counsel, Cotchett, Pitre, Simon &
20 McCarthy. Wasserman, Comden, Casselman & Pearson have assisted in the preparation of the
21 Consolidated Amended Complaint, oppositions to the numerous motions to dismiss filed by
22 defendants, oral argument thereon held in Seattle, and discovery proceedings, including
23 depositions.

25 6. Attached as Exhibit "C" hereto is a summary of the hours spent by attorneys and
26 paralegals at Wasserman, Comden, Casselman & Pearson L.L.P. over the years of this class
